

Nearly three workers will die every week from ladder falls and more than 50 will be injured daily. When we take into account the homeowner, some studies show a shocking 500,000 people are treated in emergency rooms annually for ladder related injuries.

Ladder accidents happen for many reasons. Some causes include:

- Improper ladder selection
- Use of damaged ladders
- Improper ladder setup & use
